## **Consolidating starters into groups**

Boats will be grouped into different blocks. This will limit the waiting time before the start and, if possible, multiple usage of boats can be organised.

Double usage of boats requires substantial extra effort by the organizer. Therefore it cannot be guaranteed that double usage is always possible. If teams are planning such usage this needs to be clearly stated when registering the individual teams.

Due to this new procedure it might happen that boats from one heat cannot start immediately one after another.

Teams will start rowing a few boat lengths before the starting line. The starting time will be clocked when crossing the starting line, the finishing time when crossing the finish line.

### **Race rating**

The difference between start and finish time is the racetime.

Should only one boat register within the age category of a Masters' race, then this boat will be rated in the next youngest age category. Should there be no starter in this next youngest category the boat will start in its' own original age category but without receiving a victory medal.

However, in case there originally was more than one registration for that category, and cancellations follow on race day, that boat which now is a single starter will receive a victory medal.

All races will be clocked individually. Winner ist the team with the fastest time within an age category. Racing time bonus for certain trophies are calculated as follows:

## **Trophies**

Following Trophies are awarded:

- **FARI-CUP Eight:** The eight with the largest time difference between winner and 2nd place, irrespective of gender, age and boat category.
- **FARI-CUP Four:** The four or quad with the largest time difference between winner and 2nd place, irrespective of gender, age and boat category.
- **Arno-Kruse-Eight** (Donor: Gert-Rüdiger Wüstney): To the fastest Master Gig - Eight (8+, sweep, incl. time bonus)
- **Sina Ingber Eight** (Donor: Wasser-Sportabteilung der Polizei Hamburg/Rudern): Women's eight winning boat with the largest time difference to 2nd place

Races with only one starter per category can only qualify for the Arno-Kruse-Eight trophy.

Time bonus is calculated as per the above table. Winners of the FARI-CUP do not qualify for the other trophies.

Above ,walking' cups remain property of the organizer and have to be returned by the winner for the next FARI-CUP event. They will be handed over to team captains of the winning team who are responsible to return them in time for the following year's races.

## **Team Captains**

When registering a team captain needs to be named, who is responsible for all required communication between team and organizer. Participation in the official team captains' meeting is mandatory.

## **Film/Press/Photography**

With the registration each team member agrees that photos and pictures taken of him/her during the event may be published.



### **Liability, ability to swim**

The organizer is liable for intentional wrongdoing and gross negligence.

With the registration each team member confirms being able to swim and to be fit enough for participation in the regatta.

### **Boat staging area**

The staging area is located directly in front of the Rowing Club Favorite Hammonia. This parking area is only be used by trailers. The parking section for towing vehicles is approx. 200 meters away. Parking attendants will direct the traffic.

Vehicles cannot be parked on the lawns. Bike- and walkways have to be free to use at all times. Parking in general is very limited. Public parking (garage) with parking fees is available right next to the staging area. Please check [www.faricup.de](http://www.faricup.de)

## **Time schedule**

The day before the race parking zones for the trailers are accessible as from 13.00 hr. Rowing is possible but needs to be organized individually. Restaurant/Bar is open.

On regatta day additional no parking zones for the general public are established, which may be used according to instructions on [www.faricup.de](http://www.faricup.de).

**The exact and final time schedule will be published together with the registration results.** Last minute changes are still possible on regatta day. The plan is as follows:

from 07:30	Arrivals /Parking instructions (until approx. 09.30hrs)
from 08:00	Opening regatta office and bar/restaurant
09:45	Team captains meeting for six's and fours (mandatory)
10:15	Team captains meeting for eights (mandatory)

The eights from Block 2 have to be in the starting area (North of streetbridge ' Sengelmannstraße') latest at 12.40 hr, the eights from Block 4 latest at 14.40 hr.

Within the Blocks (groups) the boats will be started with a time difference of between 30 to 60 seconds according to the starting numbers.



### **Time Penalties / Violations of course rules**

In case of violations the organization team may assess time penalties which will be added to the actual racing time. Diverting from the race course during the race in order to shorten the total distance will be punished by adding a time penalty of up to 60 seconds.

In case of violations which jeopardize the safety of others the organization team may expell those responsible from the race.

Should it be necessary during the race that the organizing team stops individual boats for safety or security reasons, these individual boats will receive a time credit to compensate for the unvoluntary stop.

### **Award Ceremony**

Is planned to start at approx. 15.45 hr. In order to hand over the four (4) trophies the complete winning teams should show up for the award ceremony, for all other winning teams only the team captains are asked to come to collect the medals..

### **Assignment of boats / boat exchanges**

All boats owned by the organizing club will be exclusively assigned by the organizing team. First priority is given to pure club teams, thereafter to mixed teams from different clubs. To let non – club members use club boats can only be arranged in special cases.

The organizing team will assist to find boats from other Hamburg-based clubs for those teams that cannot bring their own equipment. Borrowers of those boats need to carry insurance and are liable for damages.

### **Showers / Changing rooms**

Please check the notice boards. A toilet-wagon is parked in front of the club. Showers and changing rooms are provided at the Hamburger and Germania Ruderclub and at the Favorite Hammonia Ruderclub.

### **Some tips about parking**

1. As from 13.00 hr on Friday a few parking places are reserved at the street ‚Alsterufer‘ between the boathouses ‚Ruder-Club Favorite Hammonia‘ and ‚Der Hamburger und Germania RC‘.
2. Address: Hamburg, Alsterufer 9
3. On saturday (race-day) you can arrive at the boat - staging area at the street ‚Alsterufer‘ via Kennedybrücke/Alsterglasis as from 07.30 hrs. Until 09.30 hrs volunteers will be there to assist. Trailers shall be parked at the street ‚Alsterufer‘ whereas the trucks can be parked at the parking area Alsterterrasse/Siegfried-Wesells-Platz.





4. Be aware that some parking spots are limited timewise.
5. There is a parking garage at the street 'Alsterterrasse' where cars can be parked, hourly rate € 1,-
6. You can travel to the event by public transportation as well. Railroad and S-train station is 'Dammtor', the closest underground station is 'Stephansplatz' (Line U1).

### **AFTER – ROW-PARTY**
